1) Come to class once or twice a week.

4) Reread directions and passages.



5) Watch the details! Tell your student to review his work to ensure that each sentence has a capital letter and ending punctuation and spelling is correct with legible handwriting.



6) Be patient with new concepts and/or repetitions of booklets. BELIEVE IN YOUR CHILD!



7) Communicate any concerns with your center director.



8) Communicate to your child that YOU are always in charge.



9) Avoid or eliminate breaks.
